Gottschalk, Louis Moreau (Maurice?), b. May 2, 1829, New Orleans; d. Dec. 18, 1869, Rio de Janeiro. From 1841-46, pupil of Halle and Chopin (?) at Paris; performed, 1847, for the first time in Paris ; travelled afterwards in France, Spain, Switzerland, Italy ; and returned, 1853, to America. He settled in New York as a teacher ; went, 1866, to California and Brazil ; returned to New York, and died on a second visit to Brazil. He was an excellent executant—elegant, graceful, and brilliant.
